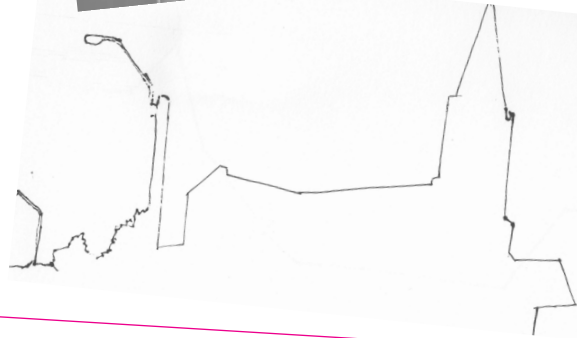
IT'S EASTER TIME!
